5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Section 83-1-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	83-1-21. The commissioner shall keep in his office for
9	public inspection all reports received by him, a record of all his
LO	proceedings, including a concise statement of the result of
L1	official examinations, an exhibit of the financial condition and
L2	methods of all insurers under his supervision, as disclosed by
L3	their statements or by official examination, and such other
L4	information with regard to them as he may deem it proper to
L5	preserve. However, all complaints or other information filed with
L6	the Commissioner of Insurance or his staff shall be considered
L7	exempt from the Mississippi Public Records Act. However, if a
L8	third party requests the information, the commissioner shall
L9	produce under subpoena the files after deleting all personal
20	information pertaining to the complaining party. The requesting
21	party shall be responsible for the cost of reproducing these
22	<pre>materials.</pre>
23	Such reports or records which are no longer useful or
24	necessary may be disposed of in accordance with approved records
25	control schedules. No records, however, may be destroyed without
26	the approval of the Director of the Department of Archives and
27	History.
