- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Beginning with the 1999-2000 school year,
- 6 the State Department of Education shall allot sufficient funding
- 7 under the minimum education program to each school district for
- 8 the purpose of employing school social workers.
- 9 (2) The State Department of Education shall determine the
- 10 amount of the additional allotment for employing a school social
- 11 worker or workers, considering the needs of school districts, as
- 12 indicated by records of the State Department of Education and the
- 13 Division of Youth Services of the Department of Human Services
- 14 which reflect incidences of crime and violence.
- 15 (3) The State Department of Education may increase the
- 16 number of social worker positions funded each year as money is
- 17 made available.
- 18 (4) Any individual employed by a school district with funds
- 19 allotted pursuant to this section must be appropriately licensed
- 20 as a social worker under Sections 73-53-1 through 73-53-29. The
- 21 State Department of Education shall specify which license a social
- 22 worker must hold as a qualification to being employed in a
- 23 position funded under this section.
- 24 (5) To qualify for minimum program funding, school social
- 25 workers must be full-time professional personnel and must spend at
- 26 least seventy-five percent (75%) of their work time in a direct
- 27 relationship with students. School social workers may not devote

- 28 more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the work day to
- 29 administrative activities related to their social work.
- 30 (6) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a school district
- 31 from employing social workers with local funds.
- 32 (7) The State Department of Education may adopt rules and
- 33 regulations regarding the activities of the school social workers.
- 34 School social workers may perform those services that are not
- 35 inconsistent with such rules and regulations.
- 36 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 1999.
