HOUSE BILL NO. 35

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-55, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 CLARIFY THE AGE FOR ELIGIBILITY IN THE DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSE; 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 63-1-55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 63-1-55. A trial judge, in his discretion, if the person so 8 convicted or who has entered a plea of guilty for any traffic 9 violation, except the offenses enumerated in paragraphs (a) through (e) of subsection (1) of Section 63-1-51 and violations of 10 the Implied Consent Law and the Uniform Controlled Substances Law, 11 12 is a minor <u>under the age of twenty-one (21) years</u> and dependent 13 upon and subject to the care, custody and control of his parents or guardian, may, in lieu of the penalties otherwise provided by 14 law and the provision of said section, suspend such minor's 15 driver's license by taking and keeping same in custody of the 16 court for a period of time not to exceed ninety (90) days. The 17 judge so ordering such suspension shall enter upon his docket 18 "DEFENDANT'S DRIVER'S LICENSE SUSPENDED FOR _____ DAYS IN LIEU OF 19 20 CONVICTION" and such action by the trial judge shall not constitute a conviction. The trial judge also may require the 21 22 minor to successfully complete a defensive driving course approved by the judge as a condition of the suspension. Costs of court and 23 penalty assessment for driver education and training program may 24 be imposed in such actions within the discretion of the court. 25 Should a minor appeal, in the time and manner as by law provided, 26

No. 35 99\HR03\R153 PAGE 1 27 the decision whereby his license is suspended, the trial judge 28 shall then return said license to the minor and impose the fines 29 and/or penalties that he would have otherwise imposed and same 30 shall constitute a conviction. <u>The provisions of this section may</u> 31 <u>only apply one (1) time for any person.</u>

32 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 33 and after July 1, 1999.
