7	SECTION 1. Beginning with the 1999-2000 school year and each
8	school year thereafter, the State Department of Education shall
9	prepare a comprehensive evaluation report on the existing state of
10	public education in each county. The comprehensive evaluation
11	report shall be a separate document from the Mississippi Report
12	Card required under Section 37-3-53. In developing the report,
13	the department shall conduct a detailed examination of all aspects
14	of education at the county level, including an evaluation of the
15	existing school buildings and property, local salary supplements
16	for teachers, salaries set by the local school board, and the
17	condition of textbooks utilized in the school district or
18	districts within that county. The comprehensive evaluation report
19	shall be published and made available to the public in conjunction
20	with the Mississippi Report Card.
