- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 93-13-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 93-13-2. (1) Any property owner shall be entitled to
- 8 recover damages in an amount not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars
- 9 (\$10,000.00), plus necessary court costs, from the parents of any
- 10 minor under the age of eighteen (18) years and over the age of ten
- (10), who maliciously and willfully damages or destroys property 11
- 12 belonging to such owner or commits any crime against such person.
- 13 However, this section shall not apply to parents whose parental
- custody and control of such child have been removed by court order 14
- 15 or decree.
- 16 (2) The action authorized in this section shall be in
- addition to all other actions which the owner is entitled to 17
- maintain and nothing in this section shall preclude recovery in a 18
- greater amount from the minor or from any person, including the 19
- 20 parents, for damages to which such minor or other person would
- 21 otherwise be liable.
- (3) It is the purpose of this section to authorize recovery 22
- from parents in situations where they are not otherwise liable and 23
- to limit the amount of recovery. The provisions of this section 24
- 25 shall apply only to acts committed on and after July 1, 1978.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26

27 and after July 1, 1999, and shall apply only to acts committed on

28 and after July 1, 1999.
