HOUSE BILL NO. 99 (As Passed the House)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 93-13-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE CIVIL LIABILITY OF PARENTS FOR CRIMINAL ACTS OF MINOR CHILDREN; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 93-13-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 93-13-2. (1) Any property owner shall be entitled to
- 8 recover damages in an amount not to exceed <u>Ten Thousand Dollars</u>
- 9 (\$10,000.00), plus necessary court costs, from the parents of any
- 10 minor under the age of eighteen (18) years and over the age of ten
- 11 (10), who maliciously and willfully damages or destroys property
- 12 belonging to such owner or commits any crime against such person.
- 13 However, this section shall not apply to parents whose parental
- 14 custody and control of such child have been removed by court order
- 15 or decree.
- 16 (2) The action authorized in this section shall be in
- 17 addition to all other actions which the owner is entitled to
- 18 maintain and nothing in this section shall preclude recovery in a
- 19 greater amount from the minor or from any person, including the
- 20 parents, for damages to which such minor or other person would
- 21 otherwise be liable.
- 22 (3) It is the purpose of this section to authorize recovery
- 23 from parents in situations where they are not otherwise liable and
- 24 to limit the amount of recovery. The provisions of this section
- 25 shall apply only to acts committed on and after July 1, 1978.
- 26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

27 and after July 1, 1999, and shall apply only to acts committed on

28 and after July 1, 1999.
