HOUSE BILL NO. 99 (As Sent to Governor)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 93-13-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE CIVIL LIABILITY OF PARENTS FOR CRIMINAL ACTS OF MINOR CHILDREN; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 93-13-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 93-13-2. (1) Any property owner shall be entitled to
- 8 recover damages in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars
- 9 (\$5,000.00), plus necessary court costs, from the parents of any
- 10 minor under the age of eighteen (18) years and over the age of ten
- 11 (10), who maliciously and willfully damages or destroys property
- 12 belonging to such owner. However, this section shall not apply to
- 13 parents whose parental custody and control of such child have been
- 14 removed by court order or decree.
- 15 (2) The action authorized in this section shall be in
- 16 addition to all other actions which the owner is entitled to
- 17 maintain and nothing in this section shall preclude recovery in a
- 18 greater amount from the minor or from any person, including the
- 19 parents, for damages to which such minor or other person would
- 20 otherwise be liable.
- 21 (3) It is the purpose of this section to authorize recovery
- 22 from parents in situations where they are not otherwise liable and
- 23 to limit the amount of recovery. The provisions of this section
- 24 shall apply only to acts committed on and after July 1, 1978.
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 1999, and shall apply only to acts committed on
- 27 and after July 1, 1999.
