4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Section 25-7-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	25-7-29. Notaries public may charge a fee in an amount of
8	not less than Two Dollars (\$2.00) nor more than <u>Seven Dollars</u>
9	(\$7.00) for services rendered, including the performance of any of
10	the following duties:
11	(a) Protesting bill or note for nonacceptance or
12	nonpayment, and giving notice;
13	(b) Registering such protest and making record;
14	(c) Attesting letters of attorney and seal;
15	(d) Notarial affidavit to an account or other writing
16	and seal;
17	(e) Each oath or affirmation and seal;
18	(f) Notarial procuration and seal;
19	(g) Certifying sales at auction and seal;
20	(h) Taking proof of debts to be sent abroad;
21	(i) Protest in insurance cases and seal;
22	(j) Copy of record and affidavit; and
23	(k) Absentee ballot applications and ballots.
24	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
25	and after July 1, 1999.
