HOUSE BILL NO. 140

AN ACT TO SET THE SALARIES OF THE ACADEMIC FACULTY OF THE MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES AT THE MIDPOINT BETWEEN THE AVERAGE SALARIES OF THE PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOLS' 3 TEACHING OR INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL AND THE SALARIES OF THE 5 ACADEMIC FACULTY OF THE STATE'S PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING OR ALTERNATIVELY, TO PROVIDE THE ACADEMIC FACULTY A \$3,000.00 SALARY INCREASE; TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF 6 7 8 EACH COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE TO PROVIDE FOR THE SALARY 9 INCREASE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE LEGISLATURE SHALL APPROPRIATE THE 10 FUNDS NECESSARY FOR THE SALARY INCREASES; AND FOR RELATED 11 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 12 SECTION 1. The board of trustees of each public community or 13 junior college shall provide for an increase in the salaries of 14 the academic faculty of not less than twenty-seven and six-tenths 15 16 percent (27.6%) or that amount necessary to raise the salaries to 17 the midpoint between the average salaries of the public secondary schools' teaching or instructional personnel and the salaries of 18 the academic faculty of the state's public institutions of higher 19 learning. As an alternative, the board of trustees of a community 2.0 or junior college may provide the academic faculty a salary 21 increase of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). 22

- 23 The Legislature shall appropriate the funds necessary to
- 24 carry out the intent and purpose of this act.
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 1999.
