- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 97-41-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 97-41-15. (1) (a) Any person who shall <u>intentionally or</u> 8
- maliciously, either out of a spirit of revenge or wanton cruelty 9
- 10 or who shall mischievously kill, maim or wound, or injure any
- livestock, or cause any person to do the same, shall be guilty of 11
- a felony and upon conviction, shall be committed to the custody of 12
- the State Department of Corrections for not less than one (1) year 13
- nor more than ten (10) years, and fined an amount not less than 14
- 15 One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), nor more than Ten
- Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00). 16
- (b) Any person who shall intentionally or maliciously 17
- kill any livestock of another and dismember or mutilate such 18
- 19 carcass, or cause any person to do the same, shall be guilty of a
- 20 felony and upon conviction, shall be committed to the custody of
- the State Department of Corrections for not less than one (1) year 21
- 22 nor more than ten (10) years, and fined an amount not less than
