HOUSE BILL NO. 153

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-75-107, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MISSISSIPPI ATHLETIC
3 COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. Section 75-75-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 75-75-107. Each member of the commission shall receive per
8 diem in accordance with Section 25-3-69 and shall be paid
9 traveling expenses while engaged in the performance of his
10 official duties in accordance with Section 25-3-41, including
11 traveling expenses for attending the National Boxing Association
12 Convention. The commissioners may pay all such national
13 affiliation dues as may be existing against the Athletic
14 Commission, as in their discretion, may be necessary, out of the
15 funds collected by the recorder of permits and licenses, and on
16 order and approval of the commission. The chairman of the
17 commission shall be ex officio the recorder of permits and
18 licenses and for his service as such shall receive an annual
19 salary equal to Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00). The
20 chairman shall not be deemed a state employee for purposes of
21 qualifying for state-funded retirement, group insurance, or other
22 fringe benefits.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
24 and after July 1, 1999.
