- 3 COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 75-75-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 75-75-107. Each member of the commission shall receive per
- 8 diem in accordance with Section 25-3-69 and shall be paid
- 9 traveling expenses while engaged in the performance of his
- 10 official duties in accordance with Section 25-3-41, including
- 11 traveling expenses for attending the National Boxing Association
- 12 Convention. The commissioners may pay all such national
- 13 affiliation dues as may be existing against the Athletic
- 14 Commission, as in their discretion, may be necessary, out of the
- 15 funds collected by the recorder of permits and licenses, and on
- 16 order and approval of the commission. The chairman of the
- 17 commission shall be ex officio the recorder of permits and
- 18 licenses and for his service as such shall receive an annual
- 19 salary equal to <u>Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00)</u>. The
- 20 chairman shall not be deemed a state employee for purposes of
- 21 qualifying for state-funded retirement, group insurance, or other
- 22 fringe benefits.
