HOUSE BILL NO. 186

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI TEACHER CENTER TO CONDUCT A 2 STUDY ON WAYS TO EFFECTIVELY RECRUIT AND RETAIN AFRICAN-AMERICAN 3 TEACHERS; TO REQUIRE THE CENTER TO SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT 4 DETAILING ITS FINDINGS TO THE 2000 LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Mississippi Teacher Center shall conduct a 8 study on the recruitment of African-American teachers for the 9 purpose of identifying factors that have a negative impact on the 10 number of African-Americans in the teaching profession and exploring various means to increase the number of 11 African-Americans in licensed teaching positions. The study shall 12 13 include, but not be limited to, the following components: 14 (a) A statement of the number of African-Americans holding licensed teaching positions compared to the total number 15 16 of licensed teachers in Mississippi; 17 (b) An analysis of the affect of various factors on the number of African-American teachers, including: state 18 demographics; admission requirements to teacher education programs 19 in the state; teacher licensing requirements; teachers' salaries; 20 21 and any other influences deemed pertinent by the Mississippi Teacher Center; 2.2 (c) Recommendations for a minority recruiting program 23 that exposes African-American students at the grade school level 24 25 to the idea of a career in teaching; (d) Recommendations for a program that would encourage 26 27 African-American assistant teachers to become licensed teachers;

(e) Recommendations for an effective process for hiring
and retaining African-American licensed teachers, from within
state and out of state, and persons who exhibit potential for a
career in teaching.

33 Before January 10, 2000, the Mississippi Teacher Center shall 34 submit a written report detailing the results of its study and 35 recommending any legislation necessary for the implementation of 36 its proposals to the Legislature.

37 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from38 and after its passage.
