- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-753, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR VOTE FRAUD IN VOTING BY ABSENTEE 1

- INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR A PERSON SELLING OR OFFERING TO SELL HIS

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 23-15-753, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows:
- 23-15-753. Any person who willfully, unlawfully and 9
- feloniously procures, seeks to procure, or seeks to influence the 10
- vote of any person voting by absentee ballot, by the payment of 11
- money, the promise of payment of money, or by the delivery of any 12
- 13 other item of value or promise to give the voter any item of
- 14 value, or by promising or giving the voter any favor or reward in
- an effort to influence his vote, or any person who aids, abets, 15
- 16 assists, encourages, helps, or causes any person voting an
- absentee ballot to violate any provision of law pertaining to 17
- absentee voting, or any person who sells his vote for money, 18
- favor, or reward, has been paid or promised money, a reward, a 19
- favor or favors, or any other item of value, or any person who 20
- 21 shall willfully swear falsely to any affidavit provided for in
- Sections 23-15-621 through 23-15-735, shall be guilty of the crime 2.2
- 23 of "vote fraud" and, upon conviction, shall be sentenced to pay a
- fine of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.000), and sentenced to the 2.4
- custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than five 25
- (5) years nor more than ten (10) years. 26
- SECTION 2. Section 23-15-889, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 27

- 28 amended as follows:
- 29 23-15-889. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or
- 30 offer to sell his vote and it shall be likewise unlawful for any
- 31 person to offer money or anything of substantial value to anyone
- 32 for his vote. Anyone violating the provisions of this section
- 33 shall be guilty of a <u>felony</u> and upon conviction shall be fined
- 34 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) and shall be sentenced to the
- 35 <u>custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than five</u>
- 36 (5) years nor more than ten (10) years.
- 37 SECTION 3. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 38 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 39 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 40 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 41 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 42 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 43 extended.
- 44 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 46 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
