HOUSE BILL NO. 238  
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION  
2 27-19-56.15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE  
3 OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAG DECALS TO OWNERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES  
4 REGISTERED IN HANCOCK, HARRISON OR JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI,  
5 FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMMEMORATING THE TRICENTENNIAL OF THE CITY OF  
6 BILOXI; TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAG DECALS SHALL  
7 BE SOLD THROUGH THE BILOXI TRICENTENNIAL COMMISSION; AND FOR  
8 RELATED PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section  
11 27-19-56.15, Mississippi Code of 1972:

12 Section 27-19-56.15. Any owner of a motor vehicle that is  
13 registered in Hancock, Harrison or Jackson County, Mississippi,  
14 may be issued a distinctive license tag decal for each motor  
15 vehicle registered in his name, which decal shall commemorate the  
16 Tricentennial of the City of Biloxi, Mississippi. The distinctive  
17 license tag decal shall be of such size, color and design as may  
18 be agreed upon by the Biloxi Tricentennial Commission and the  
19 State Tax Commission; however, the State Tax Commission shall have  
20 final approval of the size, color and design. The distinctive  
21 license tag decals shall be prepared and sold at Twenty Dollars  
22 (\$20.00) each through the Biloxi Tricentennial Commission, and the  
23 proceeds derived from the sale of such decals shall be retained by  
24 the Biloxi Tricentennial Commission for the purpose promoting the  
25 celebration of the Tricentennial of the City of Biloxi.

26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
27 and after July 1, 1999.
