HOUSE BILL NO. 241

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE CASHING OF CHECKS THAT REPRESENT AN  
2 AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN PAYMENT OR A TEMPORARY  
3 ASSISTANCE TO NEEDY FAMILIES PAYMENT BY A LICENSEE UNDER THE  
4 GAMING CONTROL ACT OR AN EMPLOYEE OF SUCH A LICENSEE; AND FOR  
5 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE  
6 OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. A licensee or employee of a licensee shall not  
9 cash a check that represents an Aid to Families with Dependent  
10 Children (AFDC) payment or a Temporary Assistance to Needy  
11 Families (TANF) payment, or accept such a check in exchange for  
12 any chip, token or similar object.

13 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a  
14 separate code section in Chapter 76, Title 75, Mississippi Code of  
15 1972.

16 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
17 and after July 1, 1999.
