- 8 <u>SECTION 1.</u> A licensee or employee of a licensee shall not
- 9 cash a check that represents an Aid to Families with Dependent
- 10 Children (AFDC) payment or a Temporary Assistance to Needy
- 11 Families (TANF) payment, or accept such a check in exchange for
- 12 any chip, token or similar object.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a
- 14 separate code section in Chapter 76, Title 75, Mississippi Code of
- 15 1972.
- 16 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after July 1, 1999.
