HOUSE BILL NO. 257

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ANNUALLY SUBMIT A
2 REPORT DETAILING THE DISTRICT'S RENOVATION AND REPAIR NEEDS FOR
3 THE FOLLOWING FIVE YEARS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION; TO
4 PRESCRIBE THE CONTENTS OF THE REPORT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. In order for the State Board of Education to be
7 fully cognizant of the capital renovation and repair needs of
8 school districts in the state, before July 1 of each year, the
9 school board of every school district shall submit a written
10 report to the State Board of Education detailing the anticipated
11 capital renovation and repair needs of the school district for the
12 five (5) school years following the date of the report. The
13 report shall include:

14 (a) A description of the anticipated repair and
15 renovation needs of all school buildings and related facilities in
16 the school district, identifying each project specifically with
17 the local school in need of the work;

18 (b) The year in which the school board intends to
19 undertake each specific project;

20 (c) An estimate of the costs to be incurred for each
21 specific project and in meeting all anticipated repair and
22 renovation needs of the school district for the five-year period;
23 and

24 (d) A description of the funds that will be available
25 to the school district which the school board plans to allocate
26 toward paying the costs of each specific project.

27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

28 and after July 1, 1999.
