HOUSE BILL NO. 259

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-29-45, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE PENALTY FOR HARASSING OR THREATENING TELEPHONE 3 CALLS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 97-29-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 6 amended as follows: 7 97-29-45. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or 8 persons: 9 (a) To make any comment, request, suggestion or proposal over a telephone which is obscene, lewd or lascivious 10 with intent to abuse, threaten or harass any party to a telephone 11 12 conversation; 13 (b) To make a telephone call, with intent to terrify, intimidate or harass, and threaten to inflict injury or physical 14 harm to any person at the called number or to his property; 15 (c) To make a telephone call, whether or not 16 17 conversation ensues, without disclosing his identity and with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any person at the 18 called number; 19 20 (d) To make or cause the telephone of another repeatedly or continuously to ring, with intent to harass any 21 22 person at the called number;
- (f) Knowingly to permit any telephone under his control

- 27 to be used for any purpose prohibited by this section.
- 28 (2) Any person who shall be convicted of a violation of this
- 29 section shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars
- 30 (\$500.00) or imprisoned in the county jail not more than six (6)
- 31 months, or shall suffer both such fine and imprisonment. Any
- 32 person who shall be convicted of a second or subsequent violation
- 33 of this section shall be sentenced to the custody of the
- 34 Department of Corrections for not more than two (2) years. Any
- 35 person violating this section may be prosecuted in the county
- 36 where the telephone call, conversation or language originates in
- 37 case such call, conversation or language originates in the State
- 38 of Mississippi. In case the call, conversation or language
- 39 originates outside of the State of Mississippi then such person
- 40 shall be prosecuted in the county to which it is transmitted.
