Section 83-1-153, Mississippi Code of 1972, is б amended as follows: 7 83-1-153. (1) The provisions of Sections 83-1-151 through 83-1-169 shall apply to: 8 9 (a) All domestic insurers, and 10 Any other insurer doing business in this state (b) whose state of domicile has asked the commissioner to apply the 11 12 provisions of Sections 83-1-151 through 83-1-169 to such insurer. 13 (2) The provisions of Sections 83-1-151 through 83-1-169 shall not apply to a religious publication, or its subscribers, 14 15 that: (a) Is a nonprofit religious organization; 16 17 (b) Is limited to subscribers who are members of the same denomination or religion; 18 (c) Acts as an organizational clearinghouse for 19 20 information between subscribers who have financial, physical or medical needs and subscribers who choose to assist with those 21 22 needs, matching subscribers with the present ability to pay with subscribers with a present financial or medical need; 23 (d) Pays for the subscriber's financial or medical 24 needs by payments directly from one (1) subscriber to another; and 25 (e) Suggests amounts to give that are voluntary among 26

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27 the subscribers, with no assumption of risk or promise to pay

28 <u>either among the subscribers or between the subscribers and the</u>

29 <u>publication.</u>

30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after July 1, 1999.
