- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9
- SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 10
- 19-17-20, Mississippi Code of 1972: 11
- 12 <u>19-17-20.</u> In addition to such other duties as are required
- to be performed under the provisions of this chapter by the 13
- 14 chancery clerk, acting as county auditor, the board of supervisors
- of each county, not less frequently than once during the term of 15
