HOUSE BILL NO. 319

1	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE PHYSICIANS TO PRESCRIBE MERIDIA
2	(SIBUTRAMINE HYDROCHLORIDE MONOHYDRATE) WITHOUT RESTRICTIONS; TO
3	AMEND SECTION 41-29-137, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY
4	THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> No laws, rules or regulations shall restrict or
- 7 infringe upon the ability of a duly licensed Mississippi physician
- 8 to treat obese patients by prescribing for them Meridia
- 9 (sibutramine hydochloride monohydrate) as approved by the United
- 10 States Food and Drug Administration for weight reduction and
- 11 maintenance of weight loss. Pharmacotherapy for obese patients
- 12 shall be available as part of a comprehensive weight control
- 13 program which includes diet, exercise and behavior modification.
- SECTION 2. Section 41-29-137, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 15 amended as follows:
- 16 41-29-137. (a) Except when dispensed directly by a
- 17 practitioner, other than a pharmacy, to an ultimate user, no
- 18 controlled substance in Schedule II, as set out in Section
- 19 41-29-115, may be dispensed without the written prescription of a
- 20 practitioner. A practitioner shall keep a record of all
- 21 controlled substances in Schedule I, II and III administered,
- 22 dispensed or professionally used by him otherwise than by
- 23 prescription.
- In emergency situations, as defined by rule of the State
- 25 Board of Pharmacy, said Schedule II drugs may be dispensed upon
- 26 oral prescription of a practitioner, reduced promptly to writing
- 27 and filed by the pharmacy. Prescriptions shall be retained in

- 28 conformity with the requirements of Section 41-29-133. No
- 29 prescription for a Schedule II substance may be refilled unless
- 30 renewed by prescription issued by a licensed medical doctor.
- 31 (b) Except when dispensed directly by a practitioner,
- 32 other than a pharmacy, to an ultimate user, a controlled substance
- 33 included in Schedule III or IV, as set out in Sections 41-29-117
- 34 and 41-29-119, which is a prescription drug as determined under
- 35 Federal Control Substance Act, shall not be dispensed without a
- 36 written or oral prescription of a practitioner. Except as
- 37 <u>otherwise provided by Section 1 of this act,</u> the prescription
- 38 shall not be filled or refilled more than six (6) months after the
- 39 date thereof or be refilled more than five (5) times, unless
- 40 renewed by the practitioner.
- 41 (c) A controlled substance included in Schedule V, as
- 42 set out in Section 41-29-121, shall not be distributed or
- 43 dispensed other than for a medical purpose.
- 44 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act shall be codified in
- 45 Chapter 29 of Title 41, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 46 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 47 and after its passage.
