AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION $43\mathchar`-203$, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL GUARD TO AWARD ADULT HIGH 1 2 3 SCHOOL DIPLOMAS TO YOUTH CHALLENGE PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS WHO MEET 4 MINIMUM ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 43-27-203, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 43-27-203. (1) There is created under the Mississippi 9 National Guard a program to be known as the "Youth Challenge 10 Program." The program shall be an interdiction program designed 11 for children determined to be "at risk" by the National Guard. 12 13 (2) The Mississippi National Guard shall implement and 14 administer the Youth Challenge Program and shall promulgate rules 15 and regulations concerning the administration of the program * * *. The National Guard shall prepare written 16 guidelines concerning the nomination and selection process of 17 participants in the program, and such guidelines shall include a 18 list of the factors considered in the selection process. 19 (3) Participation in the Youth Challenge Program shall be on 20 21 a voluntary basis. No child may be sentenced by any court to participate in the program; however, a youth court judge may refer 22 the program to a child when, under his determination, such program 23 24 would be sufficient to meet the needs of the child. 25 (4) The Mississippi National Guard, under the auspices of the Challenge Academy, may award an adult high school diploma to 26 each participant who meets the requirements for a general 27

No. 355 99\HR40\R565 PAGE 1 28 educational development (GED) equivalent under the policies and 29 guidelines of the GED Testing Service of the American Council on Education and any other minimum academic requirements prescribed 30 by the National Guard and Challenge Academy for graduation from 31 32 the Youth Challenge Program. Participants in the program who do not meet the minimum academic requirements may be awarded a 33 special certificate of attendance. The Mississippi National Guard 34 and the Challenge Academy shall establish rules and regulations 35 36 for awarding the adult high school diploma and shall prescribe the 37 form for such diploma and the certificate of attendance. (5) The Mississippi National Guard may accept any available 38 funds that may be used to defray the expenses of the program, 39 including, but not limited to, federal funding, public or private 40 funds and any funds that may be appropriated by the Legislature 41

42 for that purpose.

43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 1999.
