HOUSE BILL NO. 358 (As Sent to Governor)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-17, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL GUARD MAY BE
- 3 CLASSIFIED AS IN-STATE RESIDENTS FOR PURPOSES OF UNIVERSITY AND
- 4 COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGE TUITION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37-103-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-103-17. Members of the United States Armed Forces on
- 9 extended active duty and stationed within the State of Mississippi
- 10 <u>and members of the Mississippi National Guard</u> may be classified as
- 11 residents, for the purpose of attendance at state-supported
- 12 institutions of higher learning and <u>community and</u> junior colleges
- 13 of the State of Mississippi. Resident status of such military
- 14 personnel who are not legal residents of Mississippi, as defined
- in Section 37-103-13, shall terminate upon their reassignment for
- 16 duty in the continental United States outside the State of
- 17 Mississippi.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 1999.
