## HOUSE BILL NO. 367

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 33-11-18, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE STATE AUDITOR TO AUDIT THE CAMP SHELBY TIMBER FUND; 1 2 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 33-11-18, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 33-11-18. (1) In order to conserve and promote timber
- 8 development at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, the State Forestry
- 9 Commission shall lend its services, advice and recommendations to
- the Adjutant General of Mississippi in developing a sound timber 10
- management program on state-owned lands in the military 11
- 12 reservation.
- 13 The Adjutant General may sell trees, timber, stumps,
- naval stores faces or other forest products on state-owned lands 14
- in the military reservation at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, as shall 15
- be recommended by the State Forestry Commission and to secure the 16
- services of the State Forestry Commission in the reforestation and 17
- use of planting, cutting and practices recommended by the State 18
- Forestry Commission. The Adjutant General, however, is empowered 19
- 20 to cut timber to provide clearing for military purposes and for
- rights-of-way without recommendation of the State Forestry 21
- 22 Commission, and <u>may</u> sell <u>the</u> timber at the prevailing scale
- without advertising for bids, when the value thereof is estimated 23
- at less than One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) by the 24
- State Forestry Commission. Based on the recommendation and value 25
- 26 estimate of the State Forestry Commission, the Adjutant General

27 may sell at the prevailing price, without advertising for bids,
```

- 28 timber which has been damaged by storm, fire, insect, disease or
- 29 otherwise. Based on recommendations by the State Forestry
- 30 Commission, as provided by the Timber Management Program, the
- 31 Adjutant General may dispose of nonmarketable timber that is
- 32 diseased or has been deadened by the State Forestry Commission,
- 33 authorizing noncommercial public cutting when considered in the
- 34 best interest of the state. Provided, however, that before any
- 35 other sale of timber may be made as \* \* \* authorized <u>in this</u>
- 36 <u>section</u>, the Adjutant General shall advertise for bids on the
- 37 timber in a newspaper of general circulation in the State of
- 38 Mississippi at least once each week for three (3) consecutive
- 39 weeks before the date upon which bids are to be received.
- The Adjutant General may pay all of the funds derived from
- 41 any timber and other forest product sales on state-owned lands in
- 42 the reservation into a special fund in the State Treasury, which
- 43 shall be a revolving fund, to be used for the maintenance,
- 44 development and improvement of the military reservation at Camp
- 45 Shelby, Mississippi, and out of which the Adjutant General may pay
- 46 the State Forestry Commission the cost incurred by the State
- 47 Forestry Commission in selecting and cutting trees, tree planting,
- 48 elimination of undesirable trees and shrubs, construction of fire
- 49 lanes, control of insect and disease outbreaks, and other
- 50 desirable aspects of forest management practices on this military
- 51 reservation for the benefit of this military reservation.
- The Adjutant General of Mississippi, with concurrence of the
- 53 State Fiscal Officer, may pay from available Camp Shelby timber
- 54 funds, restitution for timber \* \* \* or minerals cut \* \* \* or
- 55 removed without permission, by employees or authorized agents of
- 56 the State Military Department, from private property whose sales,
- 57 use or damage shall have enriched \* \* \* or benefited the State
- 58 Military Department.
- The funds derived from any timber and other forest product
- 60 sales as \* \* \* provided in this section shall be paid by the State
- 61 Treasurer upon warrants issued by the State Auditor of Public
- 62 Accounts and the \* \* \* Auditor shall issue his warrant upon
- 63 requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in

- 64 the manner provided by law for funds appropriated for support of
- 65 the Mississippi National Guard.
- The Adjutant General shall make an annual report to the
- 67 Legislature on receipts and disbursements in connection with all
- 68 funds derived from minerals, timber and other forest product sales
- 69 on state-owned lands at the Camp Shelby military reservation.
- 70 The State Auditor shall conduct a legal compliance audit of
- 71 the special fund created under this section once per year.
- 72 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 73 and after July 1, 1999.
