HOUSE BILL NO. 371

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-53-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN SOCIAL WORKERS AND SOCIAL SERVICES DESIGNEES
- 3 AT NURSING FACILITIES SHALL BE ISSUED SOCIAL WORKER LICENSES; AND
- 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 73-53-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 73-53-7. (1) Except as hereinafter provided, all
- 9 individuals not exempt from licensure who are not licensed under
- 10 this chapter are prohibited from performing services for
- 11 compensation for which licensure is required by this chapter, and
- 12 are also prohibited from holding themselves out to the public by
- 13 any title or description of services set out in this chapter or by
- 14 any title or description of services likely to cause public
- 15 confusion with any title or description of services set out in
- 16 this chapter.
- 17 (2) Any person not licensed under this chapter on July 1,
- 18 1993, who is actively engaged in the practice of social work
- 19 before July 1, 1994, as an employee of the State of Mississippi or
- 20 any agency, political subdivision or municipality thereof or any
- 21 community action agency or Head Start agency, and who is not
- 22 eligible to be issued a license under subsection (3) of this
- 23 section, shall be issued a provisional license as a licensed
- 24 social worker by the board, if the person applies for such
- 25 provisional license before July 1, 1994, and, at the time that the
- 26 application is made, the person is so actively engaged. The
- 27 license shall be issued by the board upon application therefor,

- 28 the submission of proof satisfactory to the board of the
- 29 applicant's employment in the practice of social work as provided
- 30 in this subsection, and the payment of the appropriate fee. Such
- 31 license shall be valid for a maximum period of two (2) years, but
- 32 not to extend past June 30, 1995, during which time the
- 33 provisional licensee must pass the AASSWB social work examination
- 34 at the basic level.
- 35 (3) Any person not licensed under this chapter on July 1,
- 36 1993, who has been actively engaged in the practice of social work
- 37 for not less than five (5) years before July 1, 1993, as an
- 38 employee of the State of Mississippi or any agency, political
- 39 subdivision or municipality thereof or any community action agency
- 40 or Head Start agency, shall be issued a license as a social worker
- 41 by the board, if the person applies for such license before
- 42 September 1, 1994, and at the time that the application is made,
- 43 the person is so actively engaged. The license shall be issued by
- 44 the board upon application therefor, the submission of proof
- 45 satisfactory to the board of the applicant's employment in the
- 46 practice of social work as provided in this subsection, and the
- 47 payment of the appropriate fee.
- 48 (4) Any person who was not licensed under this chapter on
- 49 July 1, 1993, who had been actively engaged in the practice of
- 50 social work or in practice as a social services designee for a
- 51 privately-owned nursing facility for not less than five (5) years
- 52 <u>before July 1, 1993, shall be issued a license as a social worker</u>
- 53 by the board, if the person applies for such license before
- 54 September 1, 1999, and at the time that the application is made,
- 55 the person is so actively engaged. The license shall be issued by
- 56 the board upon application therefor, the submission of proof
- 57 <u>satisfactory to the board of the applicant's employment in the</u>
- 58 practice of social work or in practice as a social services
- 59 <u>designee as provided in this subsection, and the payment of the</u>
- 60 <u>appropriate fee.</u>
- 61 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 62 and after July 1, 1999.
