HOUSE BILL NO. 385

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 15-1-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH PROVIDES THAT TEN YEARS' ACTUAL ADVERSE POSSESSION VESTS OCCUPANT WITH TITLE TO LAND; TO AMEND SECTION 89-1-55, MISSISSIPPI 1 2 3 CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 15-1-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, which 7 provides that ten (10) years' actual adverse possession of land vests occupant or possessor with full title to such land, is 8 9 repealed. 10 SECTION 2. Section 89-1-55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11 89-1-55. All lands comprising a single tract and wholly 12 described by the subdivisions of the governmental surveys, sold 13 under mortgages and deeds of trust, shall be sold in the manner 14 15 provided by Section 111 of the Constitution for the sale of lands in pursuance of a decree of court or under execution. All lands 16 17 sold at public outcry under deeds of trust or other contracts shall be sold in the county in which the land is located or in the 18 19 county of the residence of the grantor, or one (1) of the grantors 20 in the trust deed provided that where the land is situated in two (2) or more counties, the parties may contract for a sale of the 21 22 whole in any of the counties in which any part of the land lies. Sale of the lands shall be advertised for three (3) consecutive 23 24 weeks preceding such sale in a newspaper published in the county 25 or, if none is so published, in some paper having a general 26 circulation therein and by posting one (1) notice at the

courthouse of the county where the land is situated, for <u>such</u>

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- 28 time, and such notice and advertisement shall disclose the name of
- 29 the original mortgagor or mortgagors in the deed of trust or other
- 30 contract. No sale of lands under a deed of trust or mortgage
- 31 shall be valid unless such sale was advertised as provided
- 32 herein * * * regardless of any contract to the contrary. An error
- 33 in the mode of sale such as makes the sale void <u>shall</u> not be cured
- 34 by any statute of limitations. * * *
- 35 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after July 1, 1999.
