PERSONS WHO RESIDE IN PERSONAL CARE HOMES AND WHO ARE ELIGIE	LE FOR
3 AND RECEIVING CERTAIN MEDICAID ASSISTANCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE	
4 DIVISION OF MEDICAID TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM OF ASSISTANCE	
PAYMENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.	

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> As used in this act:
- 8 (a) "Division" means the Division of Medicaid in the
- 9 Office of the Governor.
- 10 (b) "Applicant" means a person who applies for personal
- 11 care home assistance payments under this act.
- 12 (c) "Recipient" means a person who resides in a
- 13 personal care home, who is eligible for assistance under the
- 14 Mississippi Medicaid Law as prescribed in Section 43-13-115, and
- 15 who is receiving Medicaid assistance for medicine, hospital
- 16 services and physician's services.
- 17 (d) "Personal care home" means any building or
- 18 buildings, residence, private home, boarding home, home for
- 19 persons eighteen (18) years of age or older, or other place,
- 20 whether operated for profit or not, which undertakes through its
- 21 ownership or management to provide, for a period exceeding
- 22 twenty-four (24) hours, housing, food service, and one or more
- 23 personal services for four (4) or more adults who are not related
- 24 to the owner or operator by blood or marriage and who require
- 25 those services, and which is licensed as a personal care home by
- 26 the State Department of Health under Section 43-11-1 et seq.
- 27 <u>SECTION 2.</u> There is established a program of assistance

- 28 payments for persons who reside in personal care homes, which
- 29 shall be administered by the Division of Medicaid. The amount of
- 30 the assistance payments shall be in the amount of Three Dollars
- 31 (\$3.00) per bed per day for each eligible recipient, subject to
- 32 appropriations therefor by the Legislature.
- 33 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Recipients of the personal care home assistance
- 34 payments shall be applicants who reside in personal care homes,
- 35 who are certified by the division as persons eligible for Medicaid
- 36 assistance, and who are receiving Medicaid assistance for
- 37 medicine, hospital services and physician's services.
- 38 <u>SECTION 4.</u> The division may adopt and promulgate reasonable
- 39 rules, regulations and standards, with the approval of the
- 40 Governor, as may be necessary for making proper and efficient
- 41 payments to all qualified recipients of personal care assistance
- 42 payments under this act.
- 43 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 1999.
