HOUSE BILL NO. 410

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-9-148, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO JUSTIFY SALARY INCREASES THAT ARE 3 INCONSISTENT WITH THE VARIABLE COMPENSATION PLAN AND TO REQUIRE 4 THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD TO REPORT TO CERTAIN LEGISLATIVE 5 COMMITTEES ON SUCH INCREASES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 25-9-148, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 25-9-148. (1) Before September 1, 1996, and before 9 10 September 1 of every year thereafter, the State Personnel Board shall prepare a written report to be submitted to the Chairmen of 11 the House of Representatives Appropriations and Fees and Salaries 12 of Public Officers Committees, the Chairmen of the Senate 13 14 Appropriations and Fees, Salaries and Administration Committees and the Legislative Budget Office specifically describing every 15 increase in compensation, other than salary increases authorized 16 by the Legislature, or additional compensation that was awarded to 17 any state officer, administrator, executive head, employee or 18 employees during the next preceding fiscal year. For each 19 increase or additional compensation awarded, the report shall 20 21 include no less than the following information: the annual salary of the officer, administrator, executive head or employee before 2.2 the increase; the total amount of the increase or additional 23 compensation; the justification for the increase or additional 2.4 compensation; the effective date of the increase or additional 25 compensation; and the source of the additional compensation, 26

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including federal or private funds.

- 28 (2) Every agency that grants a salary increase to any state
- 29 <u>officer</u>, administrator, executive head, employee or employees
- 30 which is inconsistent with the Colonel Guy Groff State Variable
- 31 <u>Compensation Plan shall submit a justification for such increase</u>
- 32 to the State Personnel Board before the expiration of the fiscal
- 33 year during which the increase is granted. The State Personnel
- 34 Board shall submit a written report of all such increases,
- 35 <u>including an analysis by the board of the justifications, to the</u>
- 36 Chairmen of the House of Representatives Appropriations and Fees
- 37 and Salaries of Public Officers Committees, the Chairmen of the
- 38 <u>Senate Appropriations and Fees, Salaries and Administration</u>
- 39 <u>Committees and the Legislative Budget Office before July 15 of the</u>
- 40 <u>next succeeding fiscal year.</u>
- 41 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 1999.
