HOUSE BILL NO. 433

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
2 THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF
3 CONDUCTING A COMPREHENSIVE STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF PROVIDING
4 ONE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM FOR ALL RETIRED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES, FOR
5 THE FISCAL YEAR 2000.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
9 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of the
10 Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of conducting
11 a comprehensive study of the feasibility of providing one health
12 insurance program for all retired public employees, for the fiscal
13 year July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$50,000.00.

14 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid
15 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
16 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
17 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
18 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
19 officers in the manner provided by law.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after July 1, 1999.
