HOUSE BILL NO. 489

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-603, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REQUIRE SIGNS TO BE ERECTED ALONG MULTILANED ROADWAYS DIRECTING $\widetilde{\text{SLOW-MOVING}}$ TRAFFIC TO USE A DESIGNATED LANE; AND FOR RELATED 3 PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-603, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 8 63-3-603. Whenever any roadway has been divided into three (3) or more clearly marked lanes for traffic, except through or 9 10 bypassing a municipality, the following rules in addition to all others consistent herewith shall apply: 11 12 (a) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practical entirely within a single lane and shall not be moved from such 13 lane until the driver has first ascertained that such movement can 14 15 be made with safety. (b) A vehicle shall not be driven in the center lane 16 17 upon a roadway which is divided into three (3) lanes except when: (i) Overtaking and passing another vehicle where 18 the roadway is clearly visible and such center lane is clear of 19 20 traffic within a safe distance;
- 23 (iii) Such center lane is at the time allocated

(ii) Such vehicle is in preparation for a left

- 24 exclusively to traffic moving in the direction such vehicle is
- 25 proceeding and is signposted to give notice of such allocation.
- 26 (c) Official signs <u>shall</u> be erected directing
- 27 slow-moving traffic to use a designated lane or allocating

turn; or

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- 28 specified lanes to traffic moving in the same direction, and
- 29 drivers of vehicles shall obey the directions of every such sign.
- 30 (d) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less
- 31 than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under
- 32 the conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand
- 33 lane then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the
- 34 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking and
- 35 passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when
- 36 preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private
- 37 road or driveway.
- 38 (e) Persons riding bicycles upon a roadway shall not
- 39 ride more than two (2) abreast except on paths or parts of
- 40 roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles. Persons
- 41 riding two (2) abreast shall not impede the normal and reasonable
- 42 movement of traffic and, on a laned roadway, shall ride within a
- 43 single lane.
- 44 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after July 1, 1999.
