HOUSE BILL NO. 492

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1 2 1972, TO AUTHORIZE DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES TO BE 3 ISSUED TO ANY HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERAN OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES; TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON WHO IS QUALIFIED TO BE 4 5 ISSUED SUCH DISTINCTIVE PLATE MAY OBTAIN A DISTINCTIVE PLATE FOR 6 EACH MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTERED IN HIS NAME; TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH 7 DISTINCTIVE PLATES SHALL BE OF A COLOR AND DESIGN AS MAY BE AGREED 8 UPON BY THE STATE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD AND THE STATE TAX 9 COMMISSION; TO AUTHORIZE THE TAX COMMISSION TO DEVELOP DECALS TO 10 BE AFFIXED TO SUCH DISTINCTIVE PLATES INDICATING THE BRANCH OF 11 SERVICE IN WHICH THE VETERAN SERVED, ANY MEDALS AWARDED TO THE VETERAN AND ANY WAR OR CONFLICT IN WHICH HE SERVED; TO PROVIDE 12 THAT THE ADDITIONAL FEE FOR SUCH DISTINCTIVE PLATES SHALL BE A 13 14 ONE-TIME FEE OF THIRTY DOLLARS; TO REVISE THE TYPES OF DOCUMENTS THAT MAY BE PRESENTED TO THE ISSUING OFFICIAL TO EVIDENCE THE 15 16 VETERAN'S MILITARY SERVICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

27-19-56.12. In recognition of the patriotic service 20 21 rendered by Mississippians who are honorably discharged veterans who served in the United States Armed Forces, * * * any such 2.2 23 person is privileged to obtain <u>a</u> distinctive motor vehicle license plate or tag for each vehicle registered in his name identifying 24 25 him as a veteran. The State Tax Commission is further authorized 26 to develop * * * decals to be affixed to the license tag 27 indicating the branch of service in which the veteran served, any 28 medals that were awarded to him and any war or conflict in which 29 he served. The distinctive plates or tags shall be of a color and design as may be agreed upon by the State Veterans Affairs Board 30 31 and the State Tax Commission. The State Tax Commission shall have final approval of the color and design. 32 33 The distinctive license plates shall be prepared by the Tax

H. B. No. 492 99\HR03\R848 PAGE 1 34 Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the 35 counties in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license plates or tags. An additional <u>one-time</u> tag fee of Thirty Dollars 36 37 (\$30.00) shall be collected by the tax collector for such license plates or tags and shall be forwarded to the Tax Commission which 38 shall deposit such fee to the credit of a fund to be administered 39 40 by the board overseeing the veterans nursing homes in this state for the benefit of indigent veterans who are residents of such 41 42 nursing homes.

An applicant for such distinctive plates shall present to the 43 44 issuing official written evidence of the veteran's service. Such evidence shall include a copy of the applicant's DD-214 form, a 45 Report of Separation From Military Service, a military discharge 46 document or a written certification of military service from the 47 State Veterans Affairs Board. The distinctive license plates or 48 49 tags so issued shall be used only upon a personally or jointly 50 owned private passenger vehicle (to include station wagons, 51 recreational motor vehicles and pickup trucks) registered in the name, or jointly in the name, of the person making application 52 therefor, and when issued to such person shall be used upon the 53 54 vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plate or license tag normally issued for such vehicle. 55

The distinctive license plates shall not be transferable between motor vehicle owners; and in the event the owner of a vehicle bearing a distinctive plate shall sell, trade, exchange or otherwise dispose of the vehicle, such plate shall be retained by such owner and returned to the tax collector.

61 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 62 and after July 1, 1999.
