- 2 TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT FOR KEEPING RECORDS ON THE SALE OF
- 3 AMMUNITION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 97-37-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 97-37-11. Every merchant or dealer or pawnbroker that sells
- 8 bowie-knives, dirk-knives, pistols, brass or metallic knuckles or
- 9 slungshots, * * * shall keep a record of all sales of such weapons
- * * * sold, showing the description of the weapons * * * so sold,
- 11 the name of the purchaser, and the description of weapons * * *
- 12 and date of sale. This record to be opened to public inspection
- 13 at any time to persons desiring to see it. The dealer who
- 14 violates this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon
- 15 conviction shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor
- 16 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 1999.
