## HOUSE BILL NO. 538 (As Sent to Governor)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 31-7-38, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXTEND THE DATE OF THE REPEALER ON THE PROVISION THAT AUTHORIZES
- 3 THE ESTABLISHMENT OF GROUP PURCHASE PROGRAMS BY CERTAIN HOSPITALS;
- 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 31-7-38, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 31-7-38. The commissioners or board of trustees of any
- 9 hospital owned or owned and operated separately or jointly by one
- 10 or more counties, cities, towns, supervisors districts or election
- 11 districts, or combinations thereof, may authorize by resolution
- 12 the organization and operation of, or the participation in, a
- 13 group purchase program with other hospitals, for the purchase of
- 14 supplies, commodities and equipment when it appears to the board
- 15 of trustees that such a group purchase program could or would
- 16 affect economy or efficiency in their operations. Purchases by
- 17 hospitals participating in group purchasing programs of supplies,
- 18 commodities and equipment through such programs shall be exempt
- 19 from the provisions of Sections 31-7-12 and 31-7-13. This section
- 20 shall stand repealed on July 1,  $\underline{2005}$ .
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 1999.
