5	REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Beginning with the 2000 Regular Session of the
- 8 Mississippi Legislature, a member of the Senate or House may not
- 9 introduce, or request the Legislative Services Office of his or
- 10 her respective house to draft, for a regular legislative session,
- 11 more than five (5) bills and more than two (2) resolutions
- 12 proposing to amend the Mississippi Constitution.
- 13 The provisions of this section do not apply to appropriation
- 14 bills.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after July 1, 1999.
