- 10 SECTION 1. Each state agency, department or institution that
- is required to submit a budget request for fiscal year 2001 and 11
- 12 for each subsequent fiscal year shall develop the request pursuant
- 13 to zero-based budgeting to the extent that each budgetary unit

- 15 (a) Upon identifying the component programs and
- describing the activities conducted by each program, specify the 16

30 year actual expenditures and the current fiscal year estimated 31 expenditures, and between the current fiscal year estimated expenditures and the budget fiscal year projected expenditures; 32 33 (d) Develop a narrative for each program justifying 34 each line-item of the itemized budgetary requirements for 35 conducting the activities of the program for the prior fiscal year actual expenditures, and justifying each line-item of the itemized 36 37 changes in the budgetary requirements for conducting the activities of the program between the prior fiscal year actual 38 39 expenditures and the current fiscal year estimated expenditures, 40 and between the current fiscal year estimated expenditures and the budget fiscal year projected expenditures. 41 42 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Joint Legislative Budget Committee and the 43 Governor's Office shall review and evaluate only those budget 44 requests developed as prescribed in paragraphs (a) through (d) of Section 1, and develop budget recommendations to the Legislature 45 starting with a base of zero dollars for each program in each 46 47 budgetary unit and adding dollars as necessary for actual expenditures on activities approved in the prior fiscal year, and 48 49 adding or reducing dollars as necessary for estimated changes in 50 expenditures approved for the current fiscal year, and adding or 51 reducing dollars as necessary for recommended changes in the expenditures deemed appropriate for the budget fiscal year. 52 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The Legislature shall determine each 53 54 appropriation for fiscal year 2001 and each subsequent fiscal year for expenditure by any state agency, department or institution by 55 56 starting with a base of zero dollars for each program in each 57 budgetary unit and adding dollars as necessary for actual
