1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-19-88, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE PROCEDURE AVAILABLE TO LANDOWNERS TO PETITION THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO PAVE COUNTY ROADS AND STREETS BORDERING THEIR LAND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI
6	SECTION 1. Section 65-19-88, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	65-19-88. (1) Whenever the owners of not less than one-half
9	(1/2) of all <u>landowners</u> bordering on any unpaved, dedicated public
10	street or road * * * located outside the boundaries of any
11	incorporated municipality of a county petition for a survey and
12	estimate of the cost of building and paving the street or road in
13	a substantial and permanent manner of asphalt, blacktop, concrete
14	or other such material equally durable, the board shall cause a
15	survey and cost estimate thereof to be made by a licensed civil
16	engineer. Thereafter, if at least three-fifths (3/5) of such
17	landowners sign and file a petition with the board of supervisors
18	along with a map or description of the land bordering such street
19	or road and designating the owners of all <u>land</u> bordering thereon,
20	requesting such street or road to be paved with the costs thereof
21	to be charged or assessed against the owners of such <u>land</u>
22	bordering thereon, the board of supervisors shall proceed to the
23	paving and permanent construction of such street or road. The
24	entire costs of paving and permanently constructing such street or
25	road * * * shall be paid by the owners of the land bordering on
26	the street or road so improved * * * by either, at the option of
27	each such <u>landowner</u> , a lump sum, one-time payment or by a special

- 28 tax imposed by the county on the <u>land</u> sufficient to pay such
- 29 <u>landowner's</u> proportionate share of the total costs. A <u>landowner's</u>
- 30 share of the total costs for building and improving such street or
- 31 road shall be determined according to the proportion which the
- 32 number of lineal feet of the owner's land which borders on the
- 33 improved street or road bears to the total number of lineal feet
- 34 of improved street or road.
- 35 (2) If one or more <u>landowners</u> elect to pay their share of
- 36 the costs of improving a street or road under subsection (1) of
- 37 this section by means of a special tax on their <u>land</u>, then the
- 38 board shall provide for the collection of taxes from the
- 39 <u>landowners</u> thereof in such annual installments as it may
- 40 determine, extending over not more than twenty (20) years, and may
- 41 borrow money in advance of the collection of such taxes, in which
- 42 event an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest shall be
- 43 collected in addition to the principal. The taxes so assessed and
- 44 levied shall be a lien upon the <u>land</u> and be collected at the same
- 45 time and in the same manner that state and county taxes are
- 46 collected. A separate assessment roll shall be provided by the
- 47 board, and the assessor shall assess the \underline{land} of each * * * owner
- 48 separately, together with the special tax assessed thereon. He
- 49 shall also mark in red ink on the general assessment roll the
- 50 particular <u>land</u> which <u>has</u> been so assessed.
- 51 (3) The provisions of this section shall not be construed as
- 52 amending or repealing the provisions of Sections 65-19-83 through
- 53 65-19-87, but shall be supplemental and additional to the
- 54 provisions contained therein.
- 55 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 56 and after July 1, 1999.
