HOUSE BILL NO. 648  
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO CAROLYN WILSON OF  
2 FORREST COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Carolyn Wilson of Forrest County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her  
7 conviction of false pretense in Forrest County, Mississippi, in  
8 1982, and her conviction of uttering forgery in Forrest County,  
9 Mississippi, in 1984, and who has completed the penalty and any  
10 conditions imposed upon her for such conviction. The Legislature  
11 has been reliably informed that she is now conducting herself as a  
12 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
14 and after its passage.
