- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 19-25-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 19-25-31. Each judge of a circuit, chancery or county court,
- or a court of eminent domain * * *, in the judge's discretion, by 8
- 9 order entered on the minutes of the court, may allow the sheriff
- riding bailiffs to serve in the respective court of such judge, 10
- not to exceed four (4) bailiffs. Any such person so employed 11
- 12 shall be paid by the county on allowances of the court on issuance
- 13 of a warrant therefor in an amount of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) for
- each day, or part thereof, for which he serves as bailiff when the 14
- court is in session. No full-time deputy sheriff shall be paid as 15
- a riding bailiff of any court. County court judges shall be 16
- limited to one (1) bailiff per each court day. 17
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18
- and after October 1, 1999. 19
