- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 19-25-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 19-25-31. Each judge of a circuit, chancery or county court,
- or a court of eminent domain * * *, in the judge's discretion, by
- order entered on the minutes of the court, may allow the sheriff 9
- 10 riding bailiffs to serve in the respective court of such judge,
- not to exceed four (4) bailiffs. Any such person so employed 11
- shall be paid by the county on allowances of the court on issuance 12
- of a warrant therefor in an amount of not less than Forty Dollars 13
- (\$40.00) nor more than Sixty Dollars (\$60.00), as established by 14
- 15 the board of supervisors, for each day, or part thereof, for which
- he serves as bailiff when the court is in session. No full-time 16
- 17 deputy sheriff shall be paid as a riding bailiff of any court.
- 18 County court judges shall be limited to one (1) bailiff per each
- 19 court day.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after October 1, 1999.
