HOUSE BILL NO. 733

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A DEVELOPER, CORPORATION OR INDIVIDUAL
DESIRING A NEW PUBLIC RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING TO BEAR THE COST OF
INSTALLING APPROPRIATE WARNING DEVICES AT SUCH CROSSING; TO
PROVIDE THAT WHEN AN EXISTING PRIVATE RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING IS
PROPOSED TO COME UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF A PUBLIC ENTITY, THE
PARTY REQUESTING THE PUBLIC CROSSING SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE
COST OF INSTALLING APPROPRIATE WARNING DEVICES BEFORE OPENING THE
CROSSING TO THE PUBLIC; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Any developer, corporation or individual
- 11 requesting or applying for a new public railroad grade crossing
- 12 shall be responsible for all costs for installing appropriate
- 13 warning devices and for obtaining easements to maintain sight
- 14 distance as deemed necessary for such crossing by a diagnostic
- 15 survey team comprised of the Mississippi Department of
- 16 Transportation Rails Engineer, a representative from the Federal
- 17 Highway Administration, a representative of the affected railroad
- 18 company and a representative of the affected local governmental
- 19 jurisdiction.
- 20 (2) When an existing private railroad grade crossing
- 21 maintained by a private party is requested to become a publicly
- 22 maintained railroad grade crossing, the private party shall be
- 23 responsible for all costs for installing warning devices and for
- 24 obtaining easements to maintain sight distances as deemed
- 25 necessary for safety of the traveling public at such crossing by
- 26 the diagnostic survey team before opening such crossing to the
- 27 public. As used in this subsection, the term "private railroad
- 28 grade crossing" means any privately maintained road or street not
- 29 under the jurisdiction of a public entity that crosses a railroad,

- 30 and which is permitted by a private railroad company to cross its
- 31 railroad tracks.
- 32 SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall be
- 33 codified in Chapter 9 of title 77, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 34 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 35 and after July 1, 1999.
