HOUSE BILL NO. 734

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 65-1-113 AND 65-1-149, MISSISSIPPI 2 CODE OF 1972, TO DELETE THE PROVISIONS WHICH RESTRICT THE 3 EXPENDITURE OF MONEY FOR HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE DURING A GENERAL 4 ELECTION YEAR AND WHICH PROHIBIT THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION 5 FROM MAKING CERTAIN PURCHASES OR LETTING CERTAIN CONTRACTS DURING 6 THE LAST SIX MONTHS OF THE TERM OF OFFICE OF ANY MEMBER OF THE 7 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 65-1-113, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows:

65-1-113. The books and accounts of the Mississippi 11 Department of Transportation shall be audited at the end of each 12 fiscal year by the State Auditor. A copy of the audit shall be 13 14 filed with the Governor, * * * the Legislative Budget Office, and 15 the Department of Finance and Administration and a copy kept on file in the Office of the Mississippi Transportation Commission. 16 17 The audit shall be so segregated that it shall show in detail the expenditures of the Mississippi Department of Transportation for 18 the period involved. 19

At <u>a</u> regular meeting in April of each year prior to the 20 beginning of each July 1 fiscal year, the Mississippi 21 22 Transportation Commission shall adopt a complete, detailed and itemized budget of each construction program, maintenance and 23 24 administration based on information as required by the Legislative Budget Office, which budget shall not exceed a reasonably 25 anticipated income of the commission for the succeeding fiscal 26 year, and the essential features of such budget shall be spread at 27 large on the minutes of the commission. A copy of the detailed 28

No. 734 99\HR40\R1029 PAGE 1 29 budget shall be filed with the Governor and three (3) copies each 30 with the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before May 30 of each year and shall 31 cover all anticipated expenditures for construction, maintenance 32 33 and all other expenditures for the ensuing fiscal year. The 34 commission shall not make expenditures in excess of its published budget or any item thereof without written notice to the 35 36 Legislative Budget Office and prior approval of the <u>Department of</u> Finance and Administration, except in case of extraordinary, 37 unusual or unprecedented occurrences arising by reason of 38 39 unforeseen events, floods, hurricanes or other acts of God or 40 force majeure, in which event, upon the declaration of emergency 41 and necessity spread at large upon the minutes, appropriate and necessary emergency expenditures may be made. * * * 42

44 SECTION 2. Section 65-1-149, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 45 amended as follows:

65-1-149. The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall 46 47 file a detailed annual report with the Governor, Department of Finance and Administration, Secretary of the Senate, Clerk of the 48 House of Representatives, and each member of the Senate and the 49 50 House of Representatives requesting one, by January 15 of each year showing by county the construction and maintenance work in 51 progress, the cost of each project with an indication of specific 52 53 cost incurred and expenses paid during the fiscal year reported, a 54 list of contracts let, a summary of the bids received, and the 55 name and address of the contractor to whom the contract was awarded in each case. The annual report of the Transportation 56 57 Commission shall also contain all receipts and disbursements 58 during the preceding fiscal period and an estimate of the receipts for not less than the next fiscal period, plus the average cost of 59 60 maintenance of each general type of road and the average cost of 61 construction of the various types of surface. Any information and 62 recommendations, including proposed legislation which in the 63 opinion of the commission is needed, shall be contained in said 64 report, in addition to any other required by law to be in the 65 annual report of every department, agency or institution.

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In addition to the report hereinabove required, there shall be presented, by January 15 of each year to the Senate Highways and Transportation Committee and to the House Transportation Committee, a report on the projected projects for the next three (3) years outlined in detail sufficient enough to facilitate an accurate assessment of such projects by such committees.

72 The Transportation Commission shall adopt a complete, detailed and itemized budget based on information as required by 73 the Legislative Budget Office, which budget shall not exceed a 74 75 reasonably anticipated income of the commission for the succeeding fiscal year, and the essential features of such budget shall be 76 77 spread at large on the minutes of the commission. A copy of the detailed budget shall be filed with the Legislative Budget Office 78 79 and the Department of Finance and Administration and shall cover all anticipated expenditures for the ensuing fiscal year. 80 The 81 commission shall not make expenditures in excess of its published budget or any item thereof without written notice to the 82 83 Legislative Budget Office and prior approval of the Department of 84 Finance and Administration, except in case of extraordinary, 85 unusual or unprecedented occurrences arising by reason of 86 unforeseen events, floods, hurricanes or other Acts of God or force majeure, in which event, upon the declaration of emergency 87 88 and necessity spread at large upon the minutes, appropriate and necessary emergency expenditures may be made. 89

The books and accounts of the Mississippi Department of 90 91 Transportation shall be audited at the end of each fiscal year by 92 the State Auditor. A copy of the audit shall be filed with the Governor, the State Auditor, the Legislative Budget Office, the 93 Department of Finance and Administration, and a copy kept on file 94 95 in the office of the <u>Transportation</u> Commission. The audit should 96 be so segregated that it shall show in detail the expenditures of 97 the Transportation Department for the period involved.
