## HOUSE BILL NO. 749

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-3-42, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY TO GRADE, GRAVEL 1 2 3 OR SHELL, AND TO REPAIR AND MAINTAIN AREAS USED FOR SCHOOL BUS PARKING AT THE PRIVATE RESIDENCE OF A SCHOOL BUS DRIVER IN THE 4 5 COUNTY; TO PRESCRIBE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR APPROVAL OF SUCH WORK BY THE COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 19-3-42, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9 19-3-42. (1) The board of supervisors of any county is 10 11 hereby authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to grade, gravel or shell, and repair, and/or maintain (a) private gravel or 12 13 shell roads or driveways to private residences if such roads or driveways are used for school bus turnarounds; and (b) areas used 14 as a school bus parking area at the private residence. 15 (2) Prior to engaging in the work authorized in subsection 16 (1) of this section, the board of supervisors shall spread upon 17 the official minutes of the board: 18 (a) Written verification by the school board that the 19 20 private residence is located on the school bus route or is the 21 residence of a school bus driver for the school district; (b) The written approval of the board of supervisors 22 23 for such work; (c) The specific location of the road, driveway or 24 25 parking area to be worked; and 26 (d) The name of the owner of the road, driveway or 27 parking area to be worked. (3) \* \* \* The approval by the board of supervisors shall be 28

H. B. No. 749 99\HR03\R709 PAGE 1 29 valid and effective for the period of time that <u>the</u> turnaround <u>or</u> 30 <u>parking area</u> is anticipated for use, but in no event for a period 31 greater than one (1) year.

(4) In addition to the authority granted in subsection (1) 32 33 of this section, from and after October 1, 1989, the board of supervisors of any county is further authorized, in its 34 35 discretion, to maintain public school grounds of the county and to grade, gravel, shell or overlay, and/or to maintain gravel, shell, 36 37 asphalt or concrete roads, driveways or parking lots of public schools of the county if, before engaging in such work, the board 38 of supervisors shall spread upon its official minutes the written 39 40 request of the school board for such work, the written approval of 41 the board of supervisors for such work and the specific location 42 of the school grounds or road, driveway or parking lot, to be 43 worked.

44 (5) In addition to any other authority granted in this 45 section, the board of supervisors of any county is hereby authorized, in its discretion, to repair and maintain driveways 46 47 and parking lots of: (a) any nonprofit organization in the county which is tax exempt under Section 501(c) of the United States 48 49 Internal Revenue Code and which has as one (1) of its primary purposes for organization to aid and assist in the rehabilitation 50 51 of persons suffering from drug abuse or drug addiction; and (b) 52 any private, nonprofit cemeteries in the county. The board of supervisors of any county shall not be authorized under the 53 54 provisions of this subsection to repair or maintain driveways or 55 parking lots located more than one hundred fifty (150) feet from the center of any highway, road or street under the jurisdiction 56 57 of the county.

58 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 and after July 1, 1999.

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
