## HOUSE BILL NO. 758

1	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF DEATH BENEFITS TO THE
2	SURVIVORS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY;
3	TO CREATE THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS BENEFITS CONTINGENCY FUND;
4	TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND; AND FOR RELATED
5	PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Whenever used in this section, the term:
- 8 (a) "Employer" means a state board, commission,
- 9 department, division, bureau, agency, county, municipality or
- 10 other political subdivision of the state, which employs, appoints
- 11 or otherwise engages the services of law enforcement officers.
- 12 (b) "Law enforcement officer" means any lawfully sworn
- 13 officer or employee of the state or any political subdivision of
- 14 the state whose duties require such officer or employee to
- 15 investigate, pursue, apprehend, arrest, transport or maintain
- 16 custody of persons who are charged with, suspected of committing,
- 17 or convicted of a crime.
- 18 (c) "Fresh pursuit" means the pursuit of a person who
- 19 has committed or is reasonable suspected of having committed a
- 20 felony, misdemeanor, traffic infraction or violation of a county
- 21 or municipal ordinance. The term does not imply instant pursuit
- 22 but pursuit without unreasonable delay.
- 23 (2) (a) The sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars
- 24 (\$25,000.00) shall be paid as provided in this section when a law
- 25 enforcement officer, while engaged in the performance of the
- 26 officer's law enforcement duties, is accidentally killed or
- 27 receives accidental bodily injury which results in the loss of the

28 officer's life, provided that such killing is not the result of

29 suicide and that such bodily injury is not intentionally

30 self-inflicted.

31 (b) The sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars

32 (\$25,000.00) shall be paid as provided in this section if a law

33 enforcement officer is accidentally killed as specified in

34 subsection (2)(a) and the accidental death occurs as a result of

35 the officer's response to fresh pursuit or to the officer's

36 response to what is reasonably believed to be an emergency. This

37 sum is in addition to any sum provided for in subsection (2)(a).

38 (c) If a law enforcement officer, while engaged in the

39 performance of the officer's law enforcement duties, is unlawfully

and intentionally killed or dies as a result of such unlawful and

41 intentional act, the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars

42 (\$75,000.00) shall be paid as provided in this section.

43 (d) Such payments, pursuant to the provisions of

subsection (2)(a) and (b), shall be made to the beneficiary

designated by such law enforcement officer in writing, signed by

46 the officer and delivered to the employer during the officer's

47 lifetime. If no such designation is made, then it shall be paid

to the officer's surviving child or children and spouse in equal

49 portions, and if there is no surviving child or spouse, then to

50 the officer's parent or parents. If a beneficiary is not

51 designated and there is no surviving child, spouse or parent, then

52 it shall be paid to the officer's estate.

(e) Such payments, pursuant to the provisions of

54 subsection (2)(a) and (b) are in addition to any workers'

55 compensation or pension benefits and are exempt from the claims

56 and demands of creditors of such law enforcement officer.

57 (f) If a full-time law enforcement officer who is

58 employed by a state agency is killed in the line of duty, the sum

of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be paid, as provided for

60 in subsection (2)(d), toward the funeral and burial expenses of

61 such officer. Such benefits are in addition to any other benefits

62 which employee beneficiaries and dependents are entitled to under

63 the provisions of the Workers' Compensation Law or any other state

64 or federal statutes.

- 65 (3) The Law Enforcement Officers Benefits Contingency Fund
- 66 shall be established in the State Treasury by an initial
- 67 appropriation of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) and
- 68 the Legislature shall make such additional appropriations as
- 69 needed to maintain a minimum balance of Five Hundred Thousand
- 70 Dollars (\$500,000.00) in said fund. Any interest accruing in the
- 71 fund shall remain in the fund. At the end of a fiscal year, any
- 72 funds remaining in the fund shall not lapse to the general fund
- 73 but shall remain in the fund.
- 74 (4) The Department of Public Safety shall adopt rules and
- 75 regulations necessary to implement and standardize the payment of
- 76 death benefits under this section and necessary to administer the
- 77 fund created by this act and to carry out the purposes of this
- 78 act. The Department of Public Safety shall be responsible for the
- 79 management of the death benefits fund and disbursement of death
- 80 benefits authorized under this section.
- 81 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 82 and after July 1, 1999.
