HOUSE BILL NO. 760

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-13-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT THE POSSESSION OR SALE OF CERTAIN TYPES OF SKY ROCKETS; TO AUTHORIZE SUCH SKY ROCKETS TO BE MANUFACTURED, POSSESSED OR STORED WITHIN THIS STATE BY MANUFACTURERS, DISTRIBUTORS AND WHOLESALERS ONLY FOR SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OUTSIDE THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO AMEND SECTION 45-13-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 45-13-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows:

45-13-1. (1) Except as herein provided, the manufacture, 11 sale, possession or use of fireworks in this state is prohibited; 12 provided, however, that except as otherwise provided in subsection 13 14 (2) of this section, the manufacture, sale, possession and use of 15 fireworks which are now or may hereafter be classified as "common fireworks" by the United States Department of Transportation, and 16 are required to be labeled * * * with the Class C common fireworks 17 label, and which were designed to produce an audible effect shall 18 contain an explosive composition not exceeding two (2) grains in 19 weight, such fireworks being referred to as safe and sane items, 20 and including such items as cone fountains, small Chinese 21 22 crackers, small nonexplosive Roman candles and rockets, and similar nondangerous items, shall be permitted within this state, 23 24 but only upon the conditions as hereinafter set forth in this 25 article. * * * (2) The manufacture, sale, possession or use of aerial 26 devices described by the United States Department of 27

28 <u>Transportation as sky rockets which have: (a) a motor tube of</u>

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less than one-half (1/2) inch outside diameter and less than three 29 30 (3) inches overall length, (b) a flight stabilizing stick of less than one-eighth (1/8) inch in minimum cross-sectional dimension 31 (side diameter), and (c) an overall length of less than fifteen 32 33 (15) inches, shall not be permitted in this state; provided, however, that such sky rockets may be manufactured, possessed or 34 stored within this state by manufacturers, distributors and 35 wholesalers only for sale or distribution outside the State of 36 <u>Mississippi.</u> 37 (3) Paper caps for use in toy guns and similar items and 38

39 nonexplosive sparklers are not included within the term
40 "fireworks" as * * * used <u>in this section.</u>

41 SECTION 2. Section 45-13-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 42 amended as follows:

45-13-3. Except as * * * provided <u>in this article</u>, no 43 44 retailer, dealer or any other person shall sell, offer for sale, store, display, or have in their possession, or use or explode 45 46 anywhere in this state (a) any fireworks that have not been 47 approved and labeled as Class C common fireworks by the United States Department of Transportation, or (b) any sky rocket 48 prohibited by Section 45-13-1(2), regardless of the manner in 49 50 which it is labeled. No jobber, wholesaler, manufacturer or any other person shall sell to retail dealers or any other person in 51 52 this state for the purpose of resale or use in this state any fireworks which do not have the United States Department of 53 54 Transportation Class C label printed on the fireworks or on the 55 smallest package in which the same are sold. The United States Department of Transportation Class C label must be visible on the 56 57 fireworks or smallest container in which the same are sold and the 58 label shall be on the fireworks or on the package or both which 59 are received by the general public from the dealer, and such label 60 shall be of such size and so positioned as to be readily seen and recognized by law enforcement officers and the public. 61 Wherever practical, such fireworks and container shall have imprinted 62 63 thereon directions for the handling thereof.

64 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 65 and after July 1, 1999.

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
