- 2 REVISE JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY AS BETWEEN JOINT TORT-FEASORS;
- 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 85-5-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 85-5-7. <u>In any action for damages where judgment is rendered</u>
- 8 against two (2) or more defendants, jointly and severally, as
- 9 joint tort-feasors, the defendants against whom such a judgment is
- 10 rendered shall share equally the obligation imposed by such
- 11 judgment, and if one (1) of such defendants pays an amount greater
- 12 than the total sum of the judgment divided by the number of
- 13 <u>defendants against whom the judgment was rendered, then the other</u>
- 14 <u>defendants shall be jointly and severally liable to him for the</u>
- 15 amount so paid in excess of his proportionate part; provided that
- 16 no defendant shall be liable to any other defendant for more than
- 17 <u>his proportionate share of the original judgment.</u>
- 18 Provided further, that in determining, for the purpose of the
- 19 above contribution, the number of defendants against whom the
- 20 judgment has been rendered, an employer and his employee, or a
- 21 principal and his agent, shall be considered as one (1) defendant

- 22 when the liability of such employer or principal has been caused
- 23 by the wrongful or negligent act or commission of his employee or
- <u>agent.</u> 24
- Provided further, that the liability of such defendants 25
- against whom such a judgment has been rendered shall be joint and 26
- several as to the plaintiff in whose favor such judgment has been 27
- 28 rendered.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 29
- 30 and after July 1, 1999.
