HOUSE BILL NO. 864

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2, CHAPTER 45, LAWS OF 1998, TO
2 TRANSFER CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE MONEY IN THE FISCAL YEAR 1999
3 APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF AGRICULTURAL AVIATION FROM ONE
4 CATEGORY TO ANOTHER.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 45, Laws of 1998, is amended
7 as follows:

8 Section 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
9 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
10 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
11 expenditure:

12 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:

13 Personal Services:

14 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 64,624.00

15 Travel and Subsistence..... 15,300.00

16 Contractual Services..... 15,719.00

17 Commodities..... 7,000.00

18 Capital Outlay:

19 Other Than Equipment..... 0.00

20 Equipment..... 3,700.00

21 Subsidies, Loans and Grants..... 0.00

22 Total..... \$ 106,343.00

23 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:

24 Permanent: Full Time. 1

25 Part Time. 0

26 Time-Limited: Full Time. 1

27 Part Time. 0

28 From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal

29 Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be
30 expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the
31 policies established by the State Personnel Board and any
32 conditions placed on such expenditures:

33 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
34 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
35 appropriated herein. Unless otherwise permitted by law, no single
36 event, including promotion, reclassification or reallocation,
37 shall exceed the greater of (1) the difference between the
38 starting salary (start step) of the current classification and the
39 new classification added to the employee's current salary (current
40 step), or (2) the salary that could be paid to an equally
41 qualified, newly hired employee. If an eligible employee is
42 currently at or above the end salary for his or her job
43 classification, then the increase authorized by subparagraphs (b),
44 (c) and (d) shall be built into the employee's base salary. To be
45 eligible, employees may not have a current performance rating
46 below "meets expectations" (2.0), as of the effective date of the
47 increase. Employees who subsequently receive a performance rating
48 of "meets expectations" or above during Fiscal Year 1999 shall
49 receive the salary increase effective the date of the rating.

50 (b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
51 Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all full
52 time employees receive a minimum increase of Six Hundred Dollars
53 (\$600.00) and not more than Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00), to the
54 next higher step.

55 (c) Funds are provided for MH-Direct Care Worker
56 Classifications to receive an average increase of One Thousand
57 Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). It is the intention of the
58 Legislature that MH-Direct Care Worker Classifications increases
59 resulting from the provisions of Senate Bill No. 2100, 1997
60 Regular Session, may be fully implemented as funds become
61 available.

62 (d) Funds are provided for a Nine Hundred Dollar

63 (\$900.00) increase for Information Technology positions. Agencies
64 may effect additional increases in accordance with the Information
65 Technology Special Compensation Plan established by the State
66 Personnel Board as funds become available.

67 It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds
68 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal
69 Year 2000 do not exceed Fiscal Year 1999 funds appropriated for
70 that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the
71 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

72 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
73 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

74 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
75 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
76 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
77 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
79 and after its passage.
