HOUSE BILL NO. 899

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-20, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 PROVIDE THAT PERSONS WHO ARE EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF
- 3 PROCURING A HUNTING LICENSE BECAUSE OF DISABILITY SHALL NOT BE
- 4 EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF SATISFACTORILY COMPLETING AN
- 5 APPROVED HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-20, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 49-7-20. (1) It is unlawful for any person born on or after
- 10 January 1, 1972, to procure any hunting license provided by the
- 11 department, or to hunt if such person is exempt from the
- 12 requirement of procuring a hunting license because of disability
- 13 <u>as authorized under Section 49-7-5(2)(a)</u>, unless the person has
- 14 been issued certification of satisfactory completion of a hunter
- 15 education course approved by the department.
- 16 (2) It is unlawful for any person to issue any license
- 17 provided by the department to any person born on or after January
- 18 1, 1972, unless the purchaser has provided valid certification of
- 19 satisfactory completion of a hunter education course approved by
- 20 the department.
- 21 (3) It is unlawful for any person to fraudulently obtain a
- 22 hunter education certification.
- 23 (4) The department may revoke any hunting license or hunter
- 24 education certification upon determination that the holder was not
- 25 entitled to issuance or obtained the license or certification by
- 26 any fraudulent means.
- 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

28 and after July 1, 1999.
