HOUSE BILL NO. 903

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE ANTIQUE AUTOMOBILE 3 LICENSE PLATES THAT DISPLAY THE EMBLEM OF THE PUBLIC OR PRIVATE COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, JUNIOR COLLEGE OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE APPLICANT'S CHOICE; TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR SUCH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 5 6

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 amended as follows:

27-19-47. (1) (a) Any citizen of the State of Mississippi 10 who owns a registered antique automobile may apply to the tax 11 collector in the county of his legal residence, on forms 12 13 prescribed by the State Tax Commission, for a special antique 14 automobile plate to be displayed on such antique automobile.

Upon receipt of an application for a special antique 15 16 automobile plate, on a form prescribed by the commission, and upon payment of the fee as prescribed in subsection (2) of this 17 section, the tax collector shall issue to such applicant a special 18 antique automobile plate on a permanent basis, and it shall bear 19 20 no date, but shall bear the inscription "Antique Car-Mississippi" 21 and shall be valid without renewal as long as the automobile is in existence. This special plate shall be issued for the applicant's 22 23 use only for such automobile and in the event of a transfer of title, the owner shall surrender the special plate to the tax 24 25 collector.

Such special antique automobile plate shall be issued in lieu 26 of, and shall have the same legal significance as, ordinary 27

28 registration plates.

(b) In lieu of the annual license tax and registration 29 30 fees levied under Mississippi law, a special license tax fee shall 31 be levied on the operation of antique automobiles. The fee for a license shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and it shall be 32 issued on a permanent basis without renewal. The fee, less five 33 percent (5%) thereof to be retained by the county tax collector, 34 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis 35 36 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 37 38 county general fund. The portion of the fee remitted to the Tax 39 Commission shall be deposited into the State Treasury on the day 40 it is received and shall be deposited by the State Treasurer into the State General Fund. 41

42 (c) For the purposes of this section, motor vehicles 43 manufactured more than twenty-five (25) years ago shall hereafter 44 be classified as antique automobiles and shall be exempt from all 45 ad valorem taxes levied by both state, municipal, county and other 46 taxing districts.

Any person who meets the requirements for the issuance 47 (2) of a special antique automobile license plate and who complies 48 with the provisions of subsection (1) of this section, at his 49 discretion, may be issued, in lieu of the distinctive license 50 plate described in subsection (1) of this section, a distinctive 51 license plate for each vehicle registered in his name which, in 52 53 addition to bearing the inscription "Antique Car-Mississippi" also displays the emblem of the public or private college, university, 54 junior college or community college of his choice. Such 55 distinctive license plates shall be issued in accordance with the 56 57 same manner and procedure, and upon payment of the same additional 58 annual fee, as prescribed under Section 27-19-56.4, 27-19-56.7 or 59 27-19-56.8. Proof of the payment of such additional annual fee

60 shall be evidenced by a decal issued by the county tax collector

63 additional annual fee shall be collected and distributed in the

64 same manner and procedure as prescribed for the additional annual

- 66 <u>27-19-56.8.</u>

67 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 68 and after July 1, 1999.
