HOUSE BILL NO. 942

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 27-19-56.15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS TO RETIRED TEACHERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section

- 8 27-19-56.15, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 9 $\underline{27-19-56.15.}$ (1) Owners of motor vehicles who are residents
- 10 of Mississippi and who are receiving monthly retirement checks
- 11 from the Mississippi Public Employees' Retirement System, or who
- 12 are receiving monthly retirement checks from an education
- 13 retirement pension program from any other state, upon complying
- 14 with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing
- 15 of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge
- 16 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
- 17 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
- 18 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, are eligible to
- 19 apply for and receive a distinctive license tag.
- 20 (2) The distinctive license tags shall be prepared by the
- 21 State Tax Commission and shall be issued through the tax
- 22 collectors of the counties in the same manner as are other motor
- 23 vehicle license plates or tags. Each distinctive license tag
- 24 shall display thereon the words "Retired Educator" and, in
- 25 addition, such numbers or letters, or both, as may be necessary to
- 26 distinguish each license tag. The distinctive tags shall be of
- 27 such color and design as agreed upon by the American Federation of

- 28 Teachers, the Mississippi Professional Educators, the Mississippi
- 29 Retired Teachers' Association and the State Tax Commission. The
- 30 State Tax Commission shall have final approval of the color and
- 31 design of the tags. (3) Applicants for the distinctive license
- 32 tags authorized by this section shall present to the issuing
- 33 official proof that they are receiving a monthly allotment as a
- 34 retired teacher from the Mississippi Public Employees' Retirement
- 35 System or from an education retirement pension program from any
- 36 other state.
- 37 (4) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 38 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 39 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 40 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 41 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 42 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 43 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 44 tag.
- 45 (5) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 46 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 47 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided
- 48 under Section 27-19-37.
- 49 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 1999.
